ONCE UPON A TIME IN MALTA



In 1955 Harry Warren Southend United's manager at the time together with a passionate supporter Peter Coombes (stationed in Malta) arranged for our club to play in a Pre-Season Tournament at the historic Empire Stadium against the top three Maltese teams (from 1954/55 season), namely Floriana, Hamrun Spartans, Sliema Wanderers. Later added were the Maltese FA and Catania, the Italian club from Sicily.

The relatives of Peter Coombes have donated an album describing the tour, using a combination of photos, newspaper cuttings and handwritten team sheets.

The Shrimpers Trust has chronicled the tour in an A4 sized book.

Our book uses Peter's Album as its base, but also contains supplemental, previously unseen material, obtained via extensive research from a variety of other sources

The book is published by the Trust, not in an attempt to make money, but to immortalise this part of our history, so that others can enjoy its contents.

To celebrate the Tour, the Shrimpers Trust has commissioned an enamel badge which it hopes will appeal to Southend United supporters as well as fans of the other tour participants.

Quid-a-Goal

Our Quid a Goal scheme is now up and running for the 2015/16 Season.



Last season the total raised was £2,000.00, which was slightly up on the 2014/15 season's total of £1,872.00.

The aim of the scheme - like most of the Shrimpers Trust's activities is to raise money for Southend United Football Club and make sure that there is a club for us to be supporting in the foreseeable future.

For the season 2015/16, money raised from this 'Quid a Goal' scheme will be donated to Ricky Duncan's Youth department to help ensure that players of the quality of Daniel Bentley and Jack Payne continue to be nurtured and made available to the first team.

This is how it works:

Those who support the scheme with a pledge have their name displayed in the United match program each week and are detailed on this web site.

We ask you to pledge £0.25, £0.50, £1.00 or more under various headings such as clean sheets, various players scoring goals, or team goals. This does not have to cost you a fortune as you can easily judge in advance how much your pledge will cost you come the end of the season.

For example, the Blues rarely manage more than 70 goals in a season from 1st team matches (14/15 League goals - 54). A £0.25 per goal pledge would therefore most likely not cost you more than £20.00 come the end of the season. If funds are tight how about £1 for every goal scored by our full backs? The 14/15 season would have cost you £1.50. If you chose to do £0.50 per point and we finished up with 80 points. At the end of the season we will write to you thanking you for your support of this initiative asking you to send us a cheque for the amount of £40.00.

Last year this scheme raised more than £2,000 from the 40+ people that helped us. This includes support by some of the Southend United's directors.

If you would like to help raise funds for this worthy cause you can do so by completing the QAG Entry Form which has been included with this newsletter and return to us either by post to the address shown on the form or by handing in at the Trust Info Stand in the Shrimpers Bar prior to any home game.





BLUES LOTTERY

The newly restructured Blues Lottery is now into its third season and after the Club's Academy was granted Category 3 status in the EPPP audit it is even more important to support the Youth Development of Southend United for the 2015/16 season onwards.
