A shiny new bus parked in Roots Hall car park, just before the Oldham game is now in the hands of Ricky Duncan and his successful academy. The Shrimpers Trust's donations have made this possible and I'd like to thank each and every one of you, our members, for your continued support. Ricky was delighted and likewise we are too!

The Trust held its AGM on the 27th November and the normal administrative process of reelecting officers and approving accounts was this time supplemented and enhanced by the attendance of Anton Ferdinand and Steve Waggott SUFC's new Chief Operating Officer.



For those unable to attend, I list below a few highlights and significant points that your Trust managed/achieved during the last 12 months.

I was pleased to announce, that despite Ron's fudge in not replacing Steve Kavanagh, we have maintained a good working relationship with the club. Although it was, at times, unclear who was responsible for what – the recent appointment of Steve Waggott addresses this and we are already seeing improvements.

The sponsored Walk to Charlton in April – raised around 11K – 50% of which went to Little Havens – a very impressive result, unlike the match on the day, of course.

The fund raiser for Alan Moody gained good momentum, raising £11,700 (final 100 arriving from a West Ham fan alienated by Vic Jobson many, many years ago, when Vic said "there are 91 other clubs you can go and support" and off he went! I have not heard from Clare or Alan recently, but I am hoping to report on what he used the funds for, at some point soon.

Our Youth Support is something we are all very proud of and we have taken a different approach this year. Our sponsorship money was not easily identifiable apparently – "black hole" was mentioned.....I'm sure that wasn't really true, but the point being, that it was hard to pinpoint exactly what our money was being spent on.

Out of that and several conversations with Ricky Duncan.....has come a shiny new bus for the Youth – (now officially launched) – this is yet more evidence of what supporters can do, if they get organised!

Whilst working on the Alan Moody campaign and having spoken to the Middlesboro ex-players association, it occurred to us that there might be some mileage in trying to create a Southend version and except for diary clashes we would have started this. I hope soon to be able to report some progress in this area. The idea being, that together with the football club, we create a group of interested ex-players to the benefit of them, the club and the fans.



And talking of Ex Players......The Trust commissioned and presented a memento to Adam Barrett at a recent event, to commemorate his time with our club and to demonstrate the fans' appreciation.

Membership numbers have held up well and we remain one of the best supported Trust, based on % ratios of average attendance to members.

In 2014, in an effort to engage more with the other supporter groups, the Trust had set up a Supporters' Forum with the idea being, to figure out how the various groups could work closer together going forward, for the mutual benefit of all.

We are pleased to report that this initiative is still going strong with all the main supporter groups represented (The Trust,

ShrimperZone, TravelZone, Disabled Supporters, The Blue Voice, All at Sea and The Exiles). The philosophy is very much about working together where there is common ground and respecting others' views, where there is a difference of opinion. Over the last year the group have met every other month with a representative of Southend United and the Club's dedicated Police Liaison Keith Baker.

Junior Blues -The Trust has been disappointed in the support from the club and the players over the last year – however, we are hoping the appointment of Steve will reverse that situation and that we can together grow and service this section in the manner originally envisaged.

Nevertheless, and despite this, the Junior Blues is growing, although perhaps not as fast as the club expected and targeted.

And finally...we made a small profit again (our outgoing Treasurer was delighted to report).

The formal proceedings over, Steve Waggott told us a little about his background, his hopes and then outlined the Club's current position with regards to "Stadium Plans" and then Anton Ferdinand took the stage and answered questions on a variety of subjects in a thoroughly engaging manner. Quid-a-Goal

Our Quid a Goal scheme is running for the 2017/18 Season.



The current total after the 27 games is £852.75.

The aim of the scheme - like most of the Shrimpers Trust's activities is to raise money for Southend United Football Club and make sure that there is a club for us to be supporting in the foreseeable future.

For the season 2017/18, some of the money raised from this 'Quid a Goal' scheme will be donated to Ricky Duncan's Youth department to help ensure that players of the quality of Daniel Bentley, Ted Smith, Jack Payne, Dru Yearwood and Elvis Bowomo continue to be nurtured and made available to the first team.

This is how it works:

Those who support the scheme with a pledge have their name displayed in the United match program each week and are detailed on this web site.

We ask you to pledge £0.25, £0.50, £1.00 or more under various headings such as clean sheets, various players scoring goals, or team goals. This does not have to cost you a fortune as you can easily judge in advance how much your pledge will cost you come the end of the season.

For example, the Blues rarely manage more than 70 goals in a season from 1st team matches (15/16 League goals - 58). A £0.25 per goal pledge would therefore most likely not cost you more than £20.00 come the end of the season. If you chose to do £0.50 per point and we finished up with 80 points, at the end of the season we will write to you thanking you for your support of this initiative asking you to send us a cheque for the amount of £40.00.

Last year this scheme raised just over £2,000 from the 60+ people that helped us. This includes support by some of the Southend United's directors.
