



It is hoped this will celebrate past achievements, help promote a positive image of the football club, as well as giving us all a bit more fun! Liam Callaghan, 24, who lives in Shoebury, suffers with Quadriplegia Cerebral Palsy and is in dire need of a power-assisted wheelchair.

Quadriplegia cerebral palsy affects all four limbs of Liam's body, making it hard for him to walk for long periods of time, write and it also affects his speech.

Recently, life has become more of a struggle for both him and his mum, Maureen. He is now becoming too heavy to manoeuvre around in his wheelchair on a day to day basis and simple tasks are now becoming much harder to complete. Many of you will know Liam and I'm delighted that donations have started really well – it would be great if we could push this target over the edge and make a real difference to one of our own in his hour of need.

Southend United Ex-Players Association (SUEPA) Passes 100!



With the signing of Dan Bentley on 13 March, SUEPA's membership reached the 100-mark, a remarkable start having only been launched just 61 days earlier. And it is not stopping there – the very next signing was none other than another superb Blues shot-stopper, Paul Sansome!

SUEPA was formed back in January, under the umbrella of The Shrimpers Trust, with the aim of re-kindling relationships between ex-players (and coaching/backroom staff), the club and the fans. Its success has been built on its Twitter feed and a five-star rated Facebook page which have nearly 900 and 500 followers respectively – items appear there for every new signing made together with pictures and other memories, and the fans are heaping praise on the initiative. "I love it, the chance to reconnect with former heroes is brilliant" is just one of the many comments received.
