
It was also very good to see a variety of other marquees and gazebos with the usual suspects and a few new ones. We made contact with many of the stall holders and intend to work with several, as partners. One in particular that seemed very relevant at present, is Andy's Man Club which the Shrimpers Trust is delighted to support.

Andy's Man Club opened its latest club, "Andy's Man Club Southend" on Monday 10th May. This new group operates from a spacious, central location in Southend, fully equipped to comply with any existing Covid-19 regulations. Andy's Man Club operates 18+ male-only, peer-to-peer, talking sessions; geared at encouraging conversation on Men's Mental Health and aiming to save lives and reduce male suicide.

This new club marks their first step into Essex, and expands the number of clubs nationwide to 61. Andy's Man Club started in Halifax over 5 years ago with some members having attended consistently for this entire period of time.

Lead Facilitator of Southend-on-Sea, Darren Smith said:

"I started to attend Andy's Man Club virtually at the start of the year after a very dark period in my life which led to me spending 6 weeks in hospital. Having looked for mental health groups locally after my discharge I wasn't able to find anything that suited, I found AMC on Twitter and I haven't looked back since. AMC has given me a focal point as part of my recovery and I'm now facilitating groups and hoping that Southend will be the first of many face2face groups to open across Essex.



My own ethos is that AMC is about helping that one man. If I can help that one man then that's a very strong reason why."

The Shrimpers Trust have run a Social Inclusion Project since 2019. Our aim is simply to bring people together and provide the opportunity to attend Roots Hall for those who would not ordinarily be able to do so, for whatever reason.

Since the launch, we have invited several groups to Roots Hall, which include:

- Kingsdown the Special Educational Needs School.
- Off The Streets the Westcliff Homeless refuge.
- The Community Coffee Club from South Woodham they try to combat loneliness.
- R.E. House a Resource & Enterprise centre that supports adults with learning disabilities.

We try to make the day more than just a football match, to create a lasting impression. The groups are usually welcomed around midday and given a tour of the stadium, as well as being given the chance to meet the manager and players, depending on timings. There are photo opportunities throughout, and food and soft drinks are provided, along with the match day tickets, either in the stands, or in executive boxes, depending on the cause.

We hope that by offering easy access and an enjoyable environment, that we will make a real difference to a number of lives.

The aim of the scheme - like most of the Shrimpers Trust's activities is to raise money for Southend United Football Club and in particular Ricky Duncan's Youth Academy helping in the progress of players such as Daniel Bentley, Jack Payne, Nathan Bishop, Elvis Bwomono, Dru Yearwood, Tom Clifford, Lewis Gard, Terrell Egbri, Harry Phillips, Charlie Kelman and Matt Rush.

This is how it works:

Those who support the scheme with a pledge have their name displayed in the United match program.

We ask you to pledge £0.25, £0.50, £1.00 or more under various headings such as clean sheets, various players scoring goals, or team goals. This does not have to cost you a fortune as you can easily judge in advance how much your pledge will cost you come the end of the season.

For example, the Blues rarely manage more than 70 goals in a season from 1st team matches. A £0.25 per goal pledge would therefore most likely not cost you more than £20.00 come the end of the season. If you chose to do £0.50 per point and we finished up with 80 points, at the end of the season we will write to you thanking you for your support of this initiative asking you to send us a cheque for the amount of £40.00.
